In the early morning hours of Tuesday, November 23, Kris shed her mortal bonds and was released from her pain and suffering following a heroic battle with a long and difficult illness. She died at home in Plain City, Utah, with her loving husband and constant companion, Todd Macfarlane, by her side.
